Abortion Ship Blocked From Moroccan Port

A Mediterranean harbour is being blocked by the Moroccan navy because of a controversial ship which offers women abortions.

The Dutch group Women on Waves is being refused entry in what is its first visit to a Muslim country.

The organisation says it is seeking to inform women about how to induce "safe legal medical abortions" as well as start the discussion on legalising it in Morocco.

Pro-life protesters, some in conservative Muslim robes and headscarves, protested against the ship's visit.

Some shouted "terrorist" and "assassin" as they approached organisers but were stopped getting too close by police.

"They have blocked the harbour. We can see a big warship in front of the harbour," Gunilla Kleiverga, a gynaecologist for Women on Waves, said from an apartment near the harbour of Smir, 40km (25 miles) east of Tangier.

"We're making an alternative plan," she said.

A government official said the port was sealed for "military manoeuvres".

The boat was invited by a women's rights group which wants to legalise abortion.

It claims that up to 800 abortions take place in the Islamic kingdom, many of them exposing the women to dangerous and sometimes fatal treatment.

Over the past 11 years the ship has visited countries including Poland, Portugal and Ireland. Its visit sparked protests from pro-life groups each time.
