Thousands of black-clad women protested across Poland Monday against a proposed near-total abortion ban in the devoutly Catholic country, where the law is already among the most restrictive in Europe. Women have been wearing black in a sign of mourning for the feared loss of reproductive rights and for the deaths that they feel some women would face. "Inhumane abortion laws are already the reality for women in Northern Ireland and could soon be the same for women in Poland". Poland's current law allows abortion through the 12th week of pregnancy if the woman's health or life is endangered, if the pregnancy results from a crime, or if the fetus is irreparably damaged. The conservative ruling party, Law and Justice (PiS), which has a majority in parliament, includes supporters of the proposal but it's not clear if there are enough to push it through. 18-month-old Georgia boy dies after being shot in home Police in Georgia said a one-year-old child died Saturday in a shooting that may have been carried out by his 3-year-old brother. According to local authorities, it seems a likely a 3-year-old child shot and killed a 1year-old in McDonough, Georgia. The laws have the support of both PiS and the Catholic Church, which claims the allegiance of about 90% of the country's population and has asked Catholics to pray for "the conscience and the light of the Holy Spirit on all Poles who protect human life from conception to natural death". According to Radio Poland, an English-language station based in Warsaw, millions of people took part in the nationwide protest. Kasia Odrozek, a protester in Germany, said there were also thousands of people taking part in Berlin. Some attribute the drop in acceptance [of abortion] to the success of the pro-life camp, borrowing tactics from those in the United States that rely on graphic imagery. Poland made news last summer when Dutch activists with the group "Women on Waves" planned a mission to fly abortion pills from Germany into Poland by drone-a stunt specifically meant to raise awareness about the lack of abortion rights in the country. The proposed bill also envisages increasing the maximum jail sentence for those who carry out abortions from two to five years. Found triumphs in O'Brien 1-2-3 at Chantilly
