Upon arrival, the entire port of Smir was blocked by Moroccan authorities, preventing the organization from operating in the country.

The Dutch ship is able to provide legal medical abortions for women who are up to six-and-a-half weeks pregnant, if anchored in international waters. They aim to reduce the number of illegally performed abortions, which can lead to excruciating health risks for the women exposed. In fact, Women on Waves claim that 600 – 800 domestic abortions take place in Morocco every day.

The women's organization has previously visited Ireland, Poland, Portugal and Spain over the past 11 years.
